



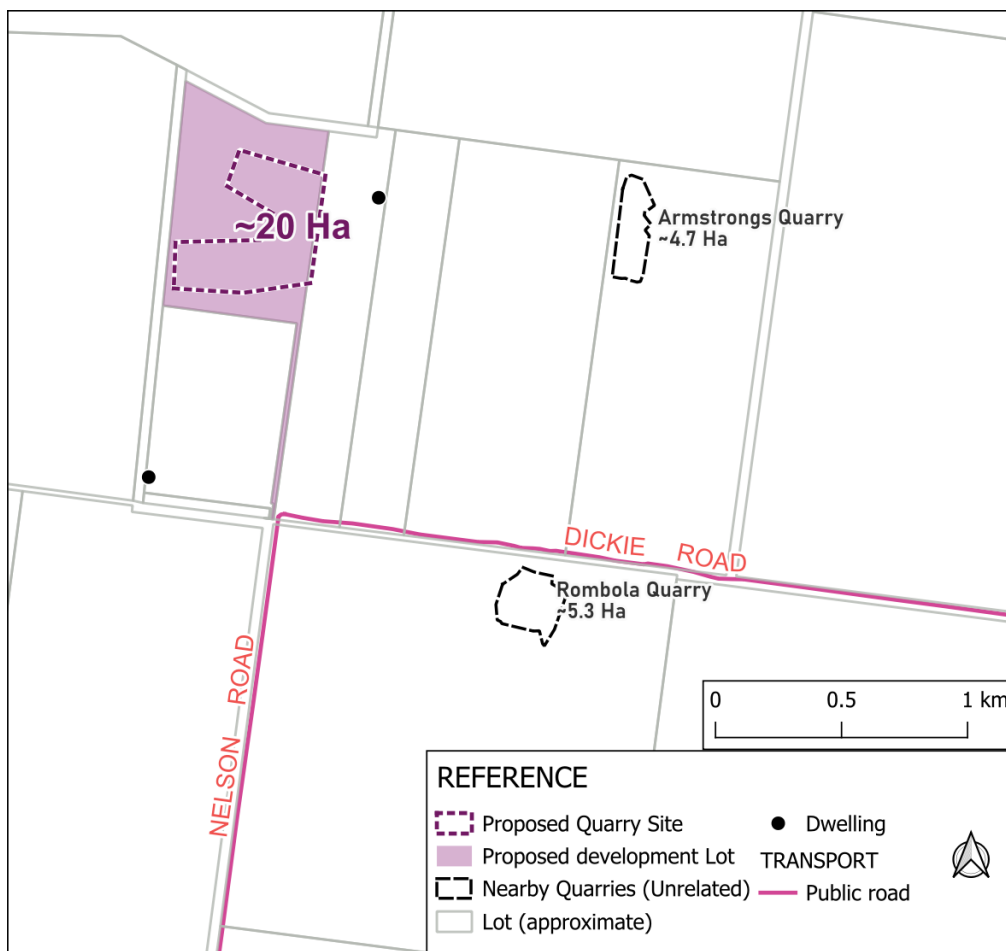

COMMUNITY NEWSLETTER 1 – PROPOSED RED PEBBLE QUARRY, TABBITA

Norman McMahon Patches Pty Ltd is proposing to establish and develop a decorative pebble gravel quarry on a site located about 21.5km in a northerly direction from Griffith, as shown Figure 1. The site address is Dickie Road, Tabbita 2652.

The Project is classified as a “designated development” under the NSW Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2021 which requires approval from the Northern Regional Planning Panel via a Development Application.

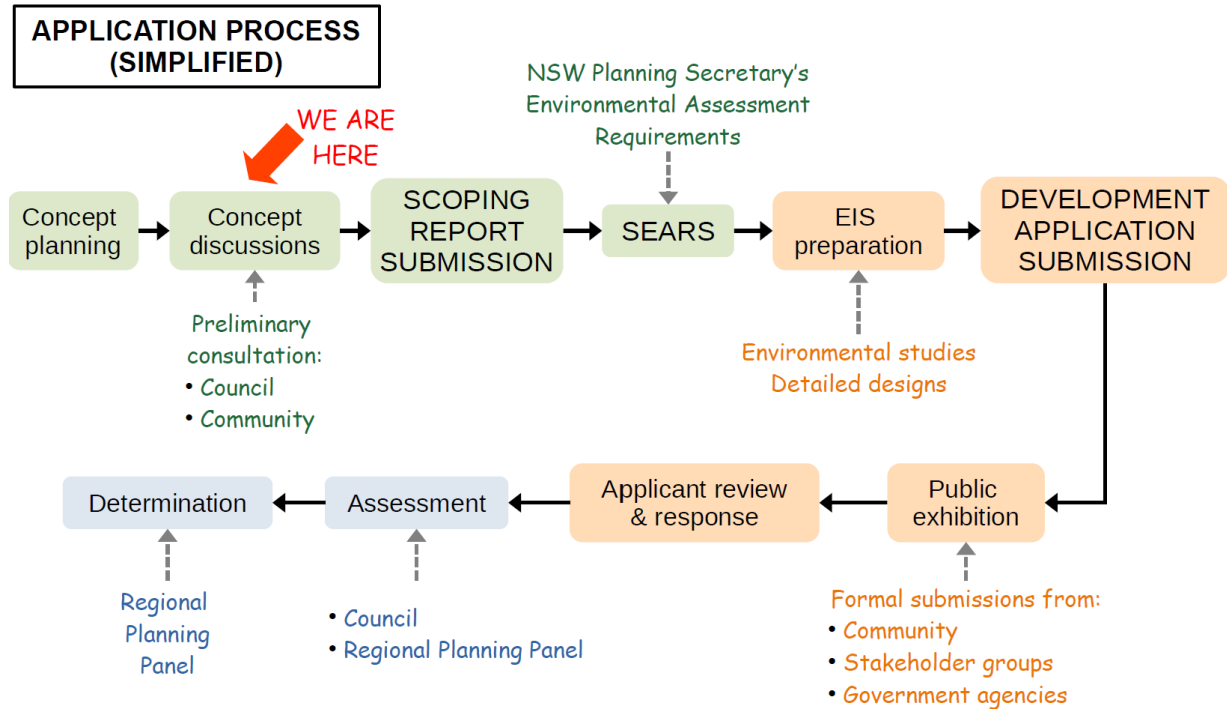


Preliminary estimates indicate there may be a resource of up to 48,000 tonnes of decorative gravel suitable for extraction. The proposed maximum;

- Annual production rate is 10,000 tonnes of gravel.
- Depth is 1.2 metres below ground level.

- Quarry extent is about 20 hectares.

As part of the Development Application process, the applicant must provide an Environmental Impact Statement and additional detailed technical assessments regarding noise, dust and traffic.



We are in the initial stages of the project planning process and are actively seeking community perspectives so that they can be considered when preparing the Environmental Impact Statement and additional technical assessments.
